



## ***Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995***

### **INTERIM PROHIBITION ORDER**

(Section 52B)

It is hereby ordered that Mr Nuwan RANKOTH of BAYSWATER, a health care worker, is prohibited from providing any health service as from the date of this order until 20 December 2024.

I, Sarah Cowie, reasonably believe that Mr Nuwan Rankoth has failed to comply with the Code of conduct for certain health care workers (Code of Conduct) and am satisfied that it is necessary to make this order to avoid a serious risk to the health, safety or welfare of the public, pursuant to section 52B(3)(b)(ii) of the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995*.

Pursuant to section 52P of the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995*, you may apply to the State Administrative Tribunal for a review of the decision to make this order.

**Note:** The terms 'health care worker' and 'health service' have the same meaning as in the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995* section 3.

The Code of Conduct is set out in Schedule 3 to the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Regulations 2010*.

Pursuant to section 52G of the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995*, a person who fails to comply with an interim prohibition order commits an offence.

Penalty: a fine of \$30,000.
