Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995

PROHIBITION ORDER

(Section 52H)

It is hereby ordered that Chaudhry Ali SHAHBAZ of DIANELLA, a health care worker, is permanently prohibited from providing any health service as from the date of this order.

Chaudhry Ali SHAHBAZ has been convicted of a prescribed offence and I, the Director, am satisfied that it is necessary to make this order to avoid a serious risk to the health, safety or welfare of the public.

Pursuant to section 52P of the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995*, you may apply to the State Administrative Tribunal for a review of the decision to make this order.

Note: The terms 'health care worker' and 'health service' have the same meaning as in the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995* section 3.

The Code of conduct for certain health care workers is set out in Schedule 3 to the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Regulations 2010*.

Pursuant to section 52N of the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995*, a person who fails to comply with a prohibition order commits an offence.

Penalty: a fine of \$30,000.
